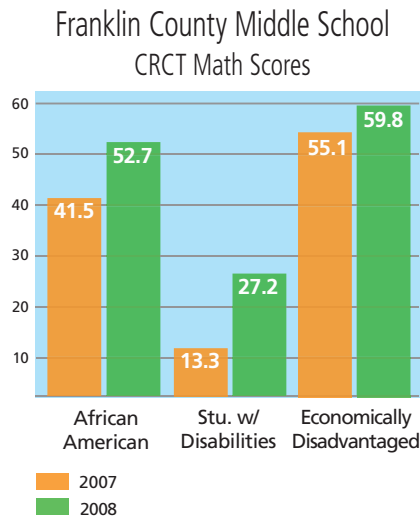

Challenge: After failing to meet AYP for the past two years, Franklin County Middle School was in its 5th year of Needs Improvement status. With low scores in math and low achievement among their African-American, Economically Disadvantaged and Special Education populations, Franklin County established a program targeted to raise performance.

Goal:

- Improve CRCT scores among target subgroups – African-American, Economically Disadvantaged and Special Education Students
- Meet AYP and stop state-directed consequences

Action Plan: Establish a schedule of lab time for Classworks math to provide adequate time on task for targeted subgroups. Make sure students are using the lab weekly and provide a mini-lab for Special Education to receive even more intensive instruction. Monitor progress and target deficiencies so that data informs instruction.

Results:

- Franklin County Middle School made AYP!
- Every targeted subgroup population had dramatic increases in their math scores over the previous year
- The Special Education students, with the most intensive instruction, more than doubled their scores
